This week's learning

- Maths: In Maths we have been learning how to partition numbers into tens and ones e.g 45 has 4 tens and 5 ones. We have also been using the greater than and less than signs < > to compare numbers.
- English: We have been making sure we are using capital letters for names of things. We wrote sentences about ourselves using capital letters and full stops for the end of the sentence.
